The next day, Mrs Goose brought us to the library. Wow, there are so many books! Can you help me find all 5 of my classmates?



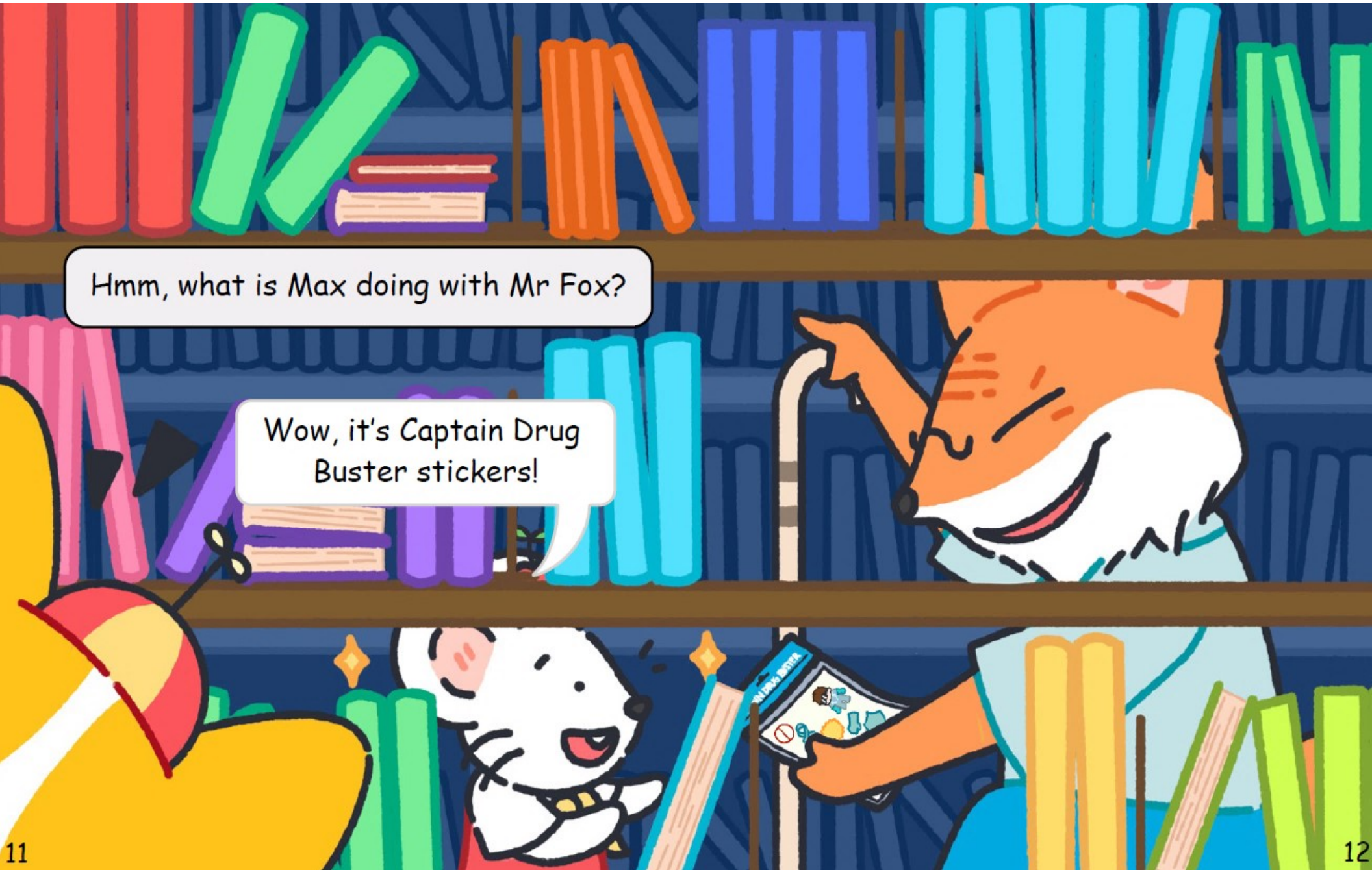

I shouldn't trust strangers so easily. I should get help from my parents or teachers if I need help. Dexter, I'm so happy to have you as my buddy.

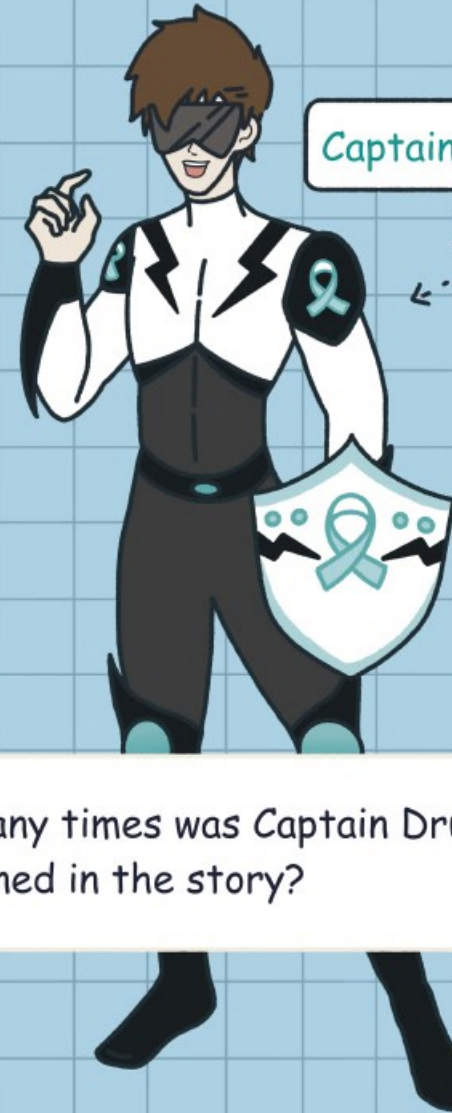
